Residency by Investment

The process of obtaining permanent residency status in a foreign country by investing there. Programs offering such benefits are widely available and come with numerous advantages over standard immigration processes. - Your proposed business operations in Canada would need to be substantially capitalized to support the business plan.
- The amount to transfer to your company account in Canada will depend on the business model planned for your Canadian branch/Subsidiary.

CANADA ENTREPRENEUR WORK PERMIT (C11)

Program Overview :

The Canada Rural Entrepreneur Stream (C11) is designed to attract skilled entrepreneurs to smaller Canadian communities outside major urban centers. The program aims to stimulate local economies by supporting business creation, expansion, and investment in cash-flow-positive ventures. It provides a clear pathway to permanent residency for business owners willing to actively manage their business and contribute to the community.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Minimum net worth and investment (varies by community)
- Minimum 2 years of business ownership or management experience
- Commitment to actively operate the business in a designated rural area
- Proof of intent to reside in the community

ALBERTA RURAL ENTREPRENEUR IMMIGRATION PROGRAM

The Alberta Rural Entrepreneur Immigration Program (AREIP) is part of the Alberta Immigrant Nominee Program (AINP) and targets entrepreneurs who wish to invest and operate businesses in smaller Alberta communities. The program encourages economic growth, job creation, and community development outside major cities. Successful applicants gain a pathway to permanent residency while growing their business in Alberta's rural regions.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Minimum personal net worth of CAD 300,000 (may vary)
- Minimum investment of CAD 200,000 in eligible rural businesses
- Minimum 3 years of business ownership or management experience
- Commitment to actively manage and operate the business in a rural Alberta community
- Must reside in the community for the duration of the program

MANITOBA RURAL ENTREPRENEUR PROGRAM

Eligibility Requirements:

- Minimum net worth of CAD 350,000
- Minimum investment of CAD 150,000 in eligible rural businesses
- Minimum 2–3 years of business ownership or management experience
- Commitment to actively manage and operate the business in a rural Manitoba community
- Must intend to reside in the community and contribute to its economy

BRITISH COLUMBIA PROVINCIAL NOMINEE PROGRAM (BC PNP)

- Creation of at least one full-time job for a Canadian citizen or permanent resident
- Intention to reside in British Columbia and support economic development

- Minimum net worth: Only \$800,000 (for businesses located inside the GTA)
- Minimum investment: Only \$600,000 (for businesses located inside the GTA)
- Minimum language proficiency: CLB 4 (Basic IELTS)
- Business Experience: At least 2 years of relevant experience
- Active Management: Intention to settle in Ontario and actively manage the business
- Opening Date: Applications scheduled to open 30 May 2026

Phase 3 – CAD 5,000 (Approx. 120 Days)

- End-to-end C11 application support
- Business plan, Letter of Intent (LOI) & complete documentation

Phase 4 – CAD 5,000 (Success-Based Fee)

- Payable only upon application approval





PROCESSING TIME

The processing time for Rural Entrepreneur Streams across Canada can vary based on several factors, including the specific immigration stream, the number of applications received, and the accuracy and completeness of your submission. In most cases, applicants can expect the overall process to take approximately 6 to 8 months.

Tip: To help reduce delays, ensure that all required documents are complete, accurate, and up to date before submission. Applicants should also be well prepared for any required interviews or community engagements, as these steps play an important role in the overall assessment and processing timeline.
